
# INDUSTRY LINKS

## Our Courses

### LEVEL 2 DIPLOMA IN HORSE CARE

This 1 year course is ideal for those wishing to expand their practical knowledge and experience of the equine industry alongside academic studies. The Level 2 Diploma is a 'hands on' course that is highly practical and will provide you with the opportunity to develop your horse care skills (with ride and non ride options).

You will be expected to be hardworking and motivated to learn, you will be involved in the daily care of the horses on the yard, helping you to develop a wide range of practical skills. You will also study the theory behind horse care helping you to appreciate and understand the importance of correct horse management.

This course is ideal preparation for a career within the equine industry or will act as a platform for further study on a Level 3 course.

### LEVEL 3 DIPLOMAS IN HORSE MANAGEMENT

This 1 or 2 year course is ideal for students wanting to gain a comprehensive understanding of equine management.

The Level 3 Diplomas give committed students a chance to develop practical, technical and academic skills. Offering Equitation and Business and Management options, the course allows you to identify with your strengths and interests.
